2014 Budget Message

Bayshore Regional Sewerage Authority Fiscal year From: January 1, 2014 to December 31, 2014

The 2014 Authority Budget of the Bayshore Regional Sewerage Authority (BRSA) is a cooperative undertaking with input from Authority Staff, Professionals, and Commissioners. The 2014 budget is comprised of operating appropriations and capital expenditures, funded through user fees, anticipated short-term financing through the NJEIT SAIL program and FEMA public assistance. The 2014 operating budget is an increase over the prior year of 7.8% while capital expenditures funded through user fees are projected to decrease by 14%. Overall, the 2014 Authority Budget remains relatively flat compared to 2013 and represents an increase in treatment charges to the contributing municipalities of less than a tenth of a percent.

The greatest percentage increase of the 2014 operating budget is in utility costs which are projected to increase 20% over last year. This is due, in part, to the impact of Hurricane Sandy. The Authority incineration system will be operating in 2014 after suffering severe flood damage in 2012. The efficiency of the system however will not be restored until 2016 and as such the use of fuel oil is expected to increase substantially in 2014 as compared to prior years. The Authority will also incur operating expenses in 2014 which are related to Hurricane Sandy damage. These expenses fall in the category of the 10% local match not reimbursable through the FEMA Public Assistance Program. The Authority also expects additional costs associated with stack testing the repaired incinerator in 2014. These additional costs account for most of the 7.8% increase in operating costs

The Authority has visited all of the contributing towns in the Regional Sewerage System in the past and will continue the process of meeting with the Administration of each town to discuss the direction of the Authority and the short and long-term goals. The Annual Plant and Collection system infrastructure inspection, which our Consulting Engineers perform, is provided to the towns by way of a bound report. In 2013 the Authority signed renewed Sewer Service Agreements with all of its contributing municipalities after several meetings with all parties.

Through the use of FEMA Public assistance funding, surplus, insurance proceeds, hazard mitigation grants the impact of Sandy on the contributing communities will be lessened. This year's budget reflects an increase to the users of less than a tenth of a percent. It is our goal to recover from the damages sustained on October 29, 2012 with the least possible impact to our users. This is especially critical given the damage sustained by these communities themselves.

BRSA will continue to find ways of reducing costs, improving efficiency, and utilizing funds wisely as it strives to be one of the most efficient and effectively run Authorities in NJ.

The Authority Capital budget was developed with staff, commissioners and professional staff input. The Authority has a prioritized 5-year capital budget which addresses treatment plant facilities, pump station facilities and collection system facilities. All of the Authority assets are categorized in one of these three systems.

The capital budget is usually derived using the prioritized 5-year capital budget program. The highest ranking priorities of each of the 3 mentioned systems within the 5 year program are selected to be implemented in the upcoming year. The Authority will however be concentrating most of its efforts on recovery from Hurricane Sandy in 2014.

The Authority will combine several funding sources including FEMA Public Assistance, insurance, hazard mitigation from both the 406 and 404 grant programs as well as short and long term funding through the NJEIT H2OLoans program and user charges to achieve its capital recovery program and continue its capital improvement plan. At this time the authority does not see the need for any significant rate increases to accomplish these goals of recovery and improvement.

There are no capital projects being undertaken in the Metropolitan or Suburban Planning areas as defined in the State Development and Redevelopment Plan, or the within the boundary of a State Planning Commission-designated Center and /or Endorsed Plan.
