Dear Resident,

The Bayshore Regional Sewerage Authority has contracted North American Pipeline Services LLC (NAP) for the Virginia Avenue Interceptor Sewer Rehabilitation project with a start date of Monday, May 11, 2020.

This contract involves rehabilitating the existing sewer system that travels along the easement between Virginia Avenue and Appleton Drive. The rehabilitation process utilizes "cured-in-place pipe," commonly referred to as "CIPP lining," which allows for a new sewer to be installed within the existing sewer without the need to excavate and replace -- which means less mess, less disruption and less time spent on your street.

In order to facilitate CIPP lining, the existing sewer will first need to be bypassed via water-tight, temporary piping that will be placed above ground along the easement. NAP crews will need to access sewer manholes in the easement, which will require passing through select driveways and yards by foot. As per the contract, no heavy machinery will enter the easement at any point.

Once bypass has been set up, a trained operator will monitor the equipment at all times. While the sewer flow is under bypass, the lining process can begin. First, a flexible felt material is saturated with a two-part resin and installed inside the existing sewer pipe. Next, the felt tube is cured by blowing steam through the sewer line, which hardens and becomes a new sewer within the existing sewer. You may observe steam clouds in the area and a mild, glue-like odor, which is temporary, harmless and will dissipate quickly.

We will take great care to not disturb or disrupt property or driveway access, though a local traffic detour will be temporarily required in the area throughout the lining process. We may ask you to move cars out of driveways temporarily and park on the street during the work. We thank you in advance for your cooperation as we work toward renewing your underground infrastructure.
